



Team Discount Policy



Discounts available:

1. Full team with league purchasing new jerseys, shorts and flag belts - \$950
2. Full team with team supplying ALL equipment from prior season - \$650
(ALL LOGOS NEED TO BE INTACT TO BE REUSED WITH NO MODIFICATIONS)
3. Full team including entry to regional tournament (*HELD IN FALL ONLY) – ADD \$350

Team requirements:

- Minimum of 8 players to receive discount
- 80% of all players MUST reside or attend school in Gilbert (No Exceptions)
- Discounted players cannot be greater than 10
- Extra players over 10 will be charged full price
 - \$125 for league purchased jersey and shorts
 - \$90 for team supplied jersey and shorts
- No tournament team can exceed 10 players

Requirements

- Team registrations have an earlier deadline and will NOT receive discount after that deadline.
- Team registrations can only be done at in person registrations
 - No online options
 - No mail in allowed
 - A team member failing to sign up with team will NOT receive discount
- Coach must submit ALL completed registrations as a complete team
 - Team roster form completed by coach
 - Individual registration forms from all new players
 - All players registered at <https://nflflag.com/register>
 - Include all completed and signed volunteer applications
 - All coaches registered at <https://nflflag.com/register>
 - Include all signed code of conducts from players and coaches
- Coaches and assistants are strongly encouraged to complete the USA Football Certification program after registering through the NFL Flag website.
- Coach needs to indicate if they will NOT accept additional players
- A coach from a discounted team can NOT receive coach discount for second team
NOTE: A coach can submit up to 3 full discounted teams
- Once team is submitted to league, no changes can be made to that team
Even if the team is under 10 player max. Additional players must pay full registration
- No refunds to individual players on a discounted team will be made by the league
- When a coach reuses jerseys and shorts from prior seasons, all jerseys and shorts MUST be identical with same color shorts for entire team and all logos intact.
- Reused equipment also requires reused shorts flag belts and balls (Balls \$20 – Belts \$5)
- Additional shorts can be added to discounted team for \$10.00 each
League will supply shorts if a team pays the \$950 discounted fee
- If a team moves in to a new division with team name already used the new team MUST change their team name and pay the price for league purchased jerseys and shorts.

Gilbert Youth Football Code of Conduct

Gilbert Youth Football League (“GYFL”) believes that: participation in any sports program plays an important role in promoting the physical, social, and emotional development of our youth. It is essential for GYFL to provide a positive and enjoyable learning experience for youth, teaching sportsmanship, fair play, Integrity, Honor, Respect, Loyalty, Personal Courage, and dedication through the game of football. Furthermore, parents, coaches, spectators, and officials involved in youth sports events should be models of such statements and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control. Gilbert Youth Football League has established this Code of Conduct and requires that you commit to be responsible for your words and actions while attending, or participating in all events and that you conform your behavior to the following Code of Conduct:

PARENT’S CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than any other outcome. I will teach my child not to feel bad about any ending result that may have happened.
2. I will encourage my child to participate by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
3. I will praise my child for trying hard and competing fairly, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
4. I will never ridicule or yell at my child, other participants, coaches or officials. I will cheer for everyone and avoid booing at all costs. I will even acknowledge other participants when they have done well.
5. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer directors, coaches and officials who give their time to my child.
6. I will not assist the coach by yelling instructions at participants unless asked by the coach.
7. I will remember that these participants are amateurs that cannot be judged by the standards of a professional team.
8. I understand that all officials do their utmost to be impartial; they try their best to provide a safe and suitable framework so that the game is well played, and I will respect their decisions.
9. I will not question any official’s calls, bias or judgment.
10. I will show respect for any opponents, because without them there would be no game.
11. I will not use profanity, nor will I harass any participants, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
12. I will remember that my child participates in sports for his/her enjoyment and not mine.
13. I will not force my child to participate in any sports program they do not wish to be in.
14. I will refrain from the use of any tobacco product, or alcoholic product while at a game or practice. I will not use drugs.
15. I will not use Gilbert Youth Football League (GYFL) or its logos in any reproduction without the written consent and full Board Approval from the Gilbert Youth Football League

FOOTBALL COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

Gilbert Youth Football League established a mission statement as it relates to the game of football. Coaches are expected to abide by this as well as this code of conduct as set forth...

With regard to my players:

I believe that my role as a coach is to contribute to the overall success, physical, and athletic growth of the player through participation in football.

- I will endeavor to be a good instructor and a positive role model for my players.
- I believe that the score of a game comes second to the safety and welfare of all my players.
- I will endeavor to put winning in its proper perspective.
- I am responsible for understanding and competing within the letter and the spirit of the rules of the Game.
- I will teach my players to understand and play within the letter and spirit of the rules, as well.

With regard to opposing teams:

I believe that the way my team conducts itself can also have an influence, for better or worse, on those we compete against.

- I will endeavor to make my team a positive role model.
- I will not coach, nor allow my players to play, with intent to cause injury to opposing players.
- Neither I nor my players and spectators will display hostile behavior towards opposing players.
- Neither I nor my players and spectators will speak in a negative manner toward any member or spectator from the opposing team.
- I will emphasize winning without boasting and losing without bitterness.

With regard to Referees:

- I believe that Referees, just as coaches and players, are attempting to do their best.
- I will instill in my players and spectators a respect for that fact.
- I understand that my attitude can influence my players and spectators.
- I will display a controlled and undemonstrative attitude toward Referees at all times.
- Neither I nor my players and spectators will address a Referee before, during or after the game in a demeaning fashion.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players and the spectators on their side of the field, specifically as it relates to the referees, coaches, players and spectators on the other team. Verbal and/or physical abuse will not be tolerated. Any coach showing this type of behavior may be suspended for a minimum of one (1) game.

If players and/or coaches conduct is not in the spirit of recreational football the referee can have the player and/or coach leave the game for a cooling off period. The same conduct rule applies to spectators. If the cooling off period does not resolve the problem, the person(s) may be asked to leave the field and/or grounds.

Coaches should avoid approaching a referee or stepping on to the field to challenge a call in a demeaning way. They may be asked to leave the game and the incident will be presented to the board to be reviewed.

I further understand that my failure to abide by this code of conduct may result in disciplinary action by the league which may include but is not limited to game suspension and/or my rights to participate as a coach for Gilbert Youth Football League.
